Paul Wolf, the architect who succeeded Hans Erlwein as Dresden's planning commissioner, spent more than two decades at the helm overseeing the capital's municipal development. One of the projects was the conversion of an antiquated power plant into a coal-fired facility between 1926 and 1928. Housed in a red brick-clad steel frame design – a classic example of Neue Sachlichkeit (New Objectivity) architecture, the plant was decommissioned in 1994. Its conversion into an event location was completed in December 2010 and the close proximity to Dresden's historical city centre makes it a popular venue.
